

Dear Colleagues,

I would like to greet you on behalf of the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society.

Unfortunately, I'm unable to be there in person due to certain commitments.

Throughout 2024, the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society, as the Azerbaijan node of the Millennium Project, focused on participating in various international conferences, as well as projects related to education, startups, and environmental issues. In November 2024, Azerbaijan will host the 29th UN Climate Change Conference (COP 29), which will be the first time it is held in a post-Soviet country. As you know, COP is an annual event where participants evaluate what has been done to achieve the goals of reducing emissions and keeping the rise in the global average temperature within 1.5°C. To strengthen international solidarity in the global fight against climate change, the President of Azerbaijan has declared 2024 the "Year of Solidarity for a Green World" in the Republic of Azerbaijan. In this context, most of the conferences attended by the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society were dedicated to ecological issues and the application of green technologies.

Our world faces serious environmental challenges, and modern technologies provide us with the tools to take better care of nature and create a more sustainable future. I believe it is fair to say that one of the primary goals of the global community today should be sustainable development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. In recent decades, the global community has recognized the need to revise priorities in the field of resource use, rationalize natural resource consumption, and shift towards green technologies.

I would particularly like to highlight our participation and presentation at the 24th International Conference "The Future of Natural Resources." It is noteworthy that some of the organizers of this conference were our Finnish colleagues from the Millennium Project, including the Finland Futures Research Centre, the Finnish Academy for the Future, and the Natural Resources Institute Finland. I would like to express special thanks to Finland Node Co-Chair Sirkka Heinonen for the invitation to the conference.

From March 6-8, 2024, we participated in an international conference in Uzbekistan, where discussions focused on creating interdisciplinary, stimulating, and critical dialogues about the future of natural resources. Azerbaijan was represented at the conference by the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society.

We presented a report titled "The Role of Green Energy in Reducing Natural Resource Usage in Azerbaijan."









But it wasn't only environmental issues that interested us in 2024. In March 2024, as President of the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society, the Azerbaijan node of the Millennium Project, I participated in the III International Research Congress "Silk Road." At the conference, we presented a report on "The Great Silk Road as a Bridge Between Different Cultures and Civilizations." I would especially like to note that today the development of the Middle Corridor (East-West), which passes through the territories where the Great Silk Road once lay, is receiving a lot of attention regarding geopolitics and economics, but culture, the spiritual foundation for building the future, is often overlooked. The challenges of the modern world strongly dictate the need to preserve the treasury of human history—the cultural heritage of the Great Silk Road. This historical route, stretching thousands of kilometers and connecting East and West, is not only an ancient trade route but also a bridge between different cultures and civilizations. The revival of the Great Silk Road is a renewal of the millennia-old dialogue of civilizations. The legacy of the Great Silk Road remains relevant in today's world. It inspires us to continue cultural dialogue and cooperation between nations, as well as to preserve and protect cultural heritage for future generations.

Additionally, 2024 has been marked by the presentation of two prestigious awards. For many years, I've dedicated myself to contributing to the development of a more cultured society and promoting renewable strategic resources for sustainable growth in Azerbaijan. Recently, I was honored to receive the Gold Medal, "The Rose of the World," in the "Peacemaker of the Planet" category from the International Humanitarian Academy "Europe-Asia."

On March 7, 2024, I was honored to be among a group of individuals recognized for our contributions to public life in Azerbaijan. By order of President Ilham Aliyev, I received the Taraggi Medal (Progress Medal) for my work as Chairman of the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society and a professor at Western Caspian University.

I would especially like to highlight that in September 2024, our country hosted the first regional stage of the World Startup Championship, organized by a member of the expert council of the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society, founder and president of "Technovate Investments," and co-founder of the "SABAH Angels Investors Club" at ADA University, Farid Ismayilzada. 

- **Purpose:** Assess progress in emission reduction, temperature increase within 1.5 degrees Celsius.


